Course Information

The Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996 set out mandatory requirements for the provision of construction safety induction training, for employees or self-employed people doing construction work at a workplace in Western Australia. The White Card meets these requirements. Anyone who is currently working on a construction site, or who wants to be required to complete this training.

Students who complete this training will receive a Statement of Attainment for CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work in the construction industry and a White Card wallet card.

Course Requirements

Participants must bring photographic identification and Unique Student Identifier (if you need help with this check our website or contact us)

Language, literacy or numeracy barriers should be advised at the time of enrolment.

Neat, casual dress standard, including enclosed footwear.

Delivery Information

Face to Face - We can deliver this course over 6 hours at your workplace if you have a group of people, or at our training facilities at 9 Craigie Street, Davenport. This duration is in line with industry recommendations for their preferred amount of training. Assessment includes verbal/written, and practical components. We offer small class sizes and our trainers are all currently working in industry.

Online - Complete the theory component online then arrange your practical assessment either at our premises or via Zoom. Contact us to enrol. It is a requirement that you must be living or working in Western Australia.

Fees

Face to face \$100

Online \$50

Participants working in the construction industry may be eligible for a subsidy through the Building Construction Fund.

Participant Support

CTS will apply reasonable adjustments to training and assessment where candidates are experiencing difficulties. Students will be provided with reassessment opportunities to assist gaining competency, however, further fees will apply if it is deemed the student needs to complete further training and assessment to obtain the unit.
